It is characterized by sudden dizaness, weakness and severe pains and aches over the body, high fever, hot eyes which do not stand the light, sore throat and sometimes bronchitis. This bronchitis in severe cases takes on the form of broucho-pneumonia which is of a virulent type. This disease is caught from the other person having it. This is trom the discharges from the nose and throat, whether from the spray of a cough or sneeze or from some article contaminated by such discharges.

The person suffering from the disease should stay at home and by himself if possible, should spit onto a newspaper and then burn it, and should cough or sneeze into a cloth which should then be burned or boiled. The germs should not be allowed to get into the air and infect others. The more the disease is spread the more dangerous it becomes.

Well persons should keep away from those suffering from the disease as much as possible and should see that tae sick observe the rules laid down above. They should also especially keep their feet dry and warm and their bowels open.
