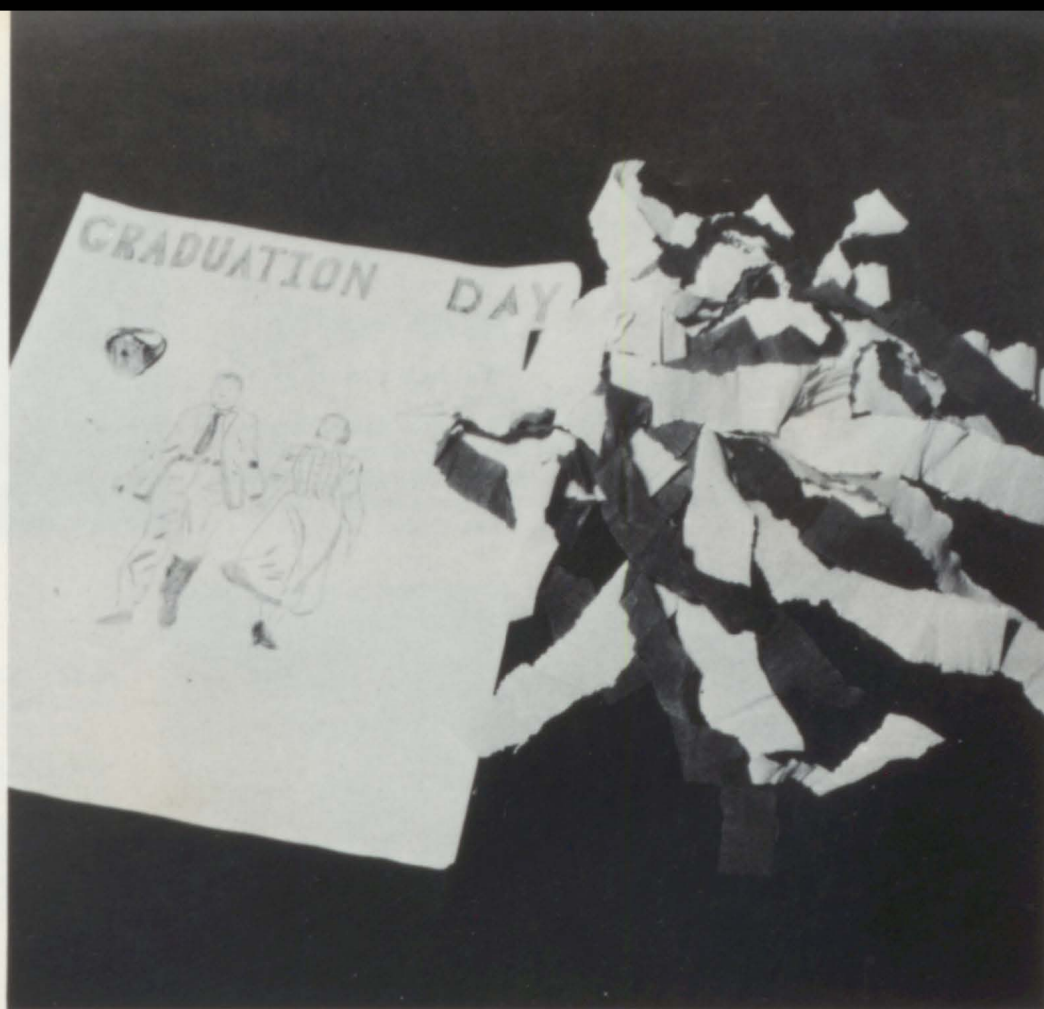


"Shy Guy"

We had lots of fun at the Liner after football and basketball games. Bermuda shorts were all the rage. Denny hated Jeannette's red ones.

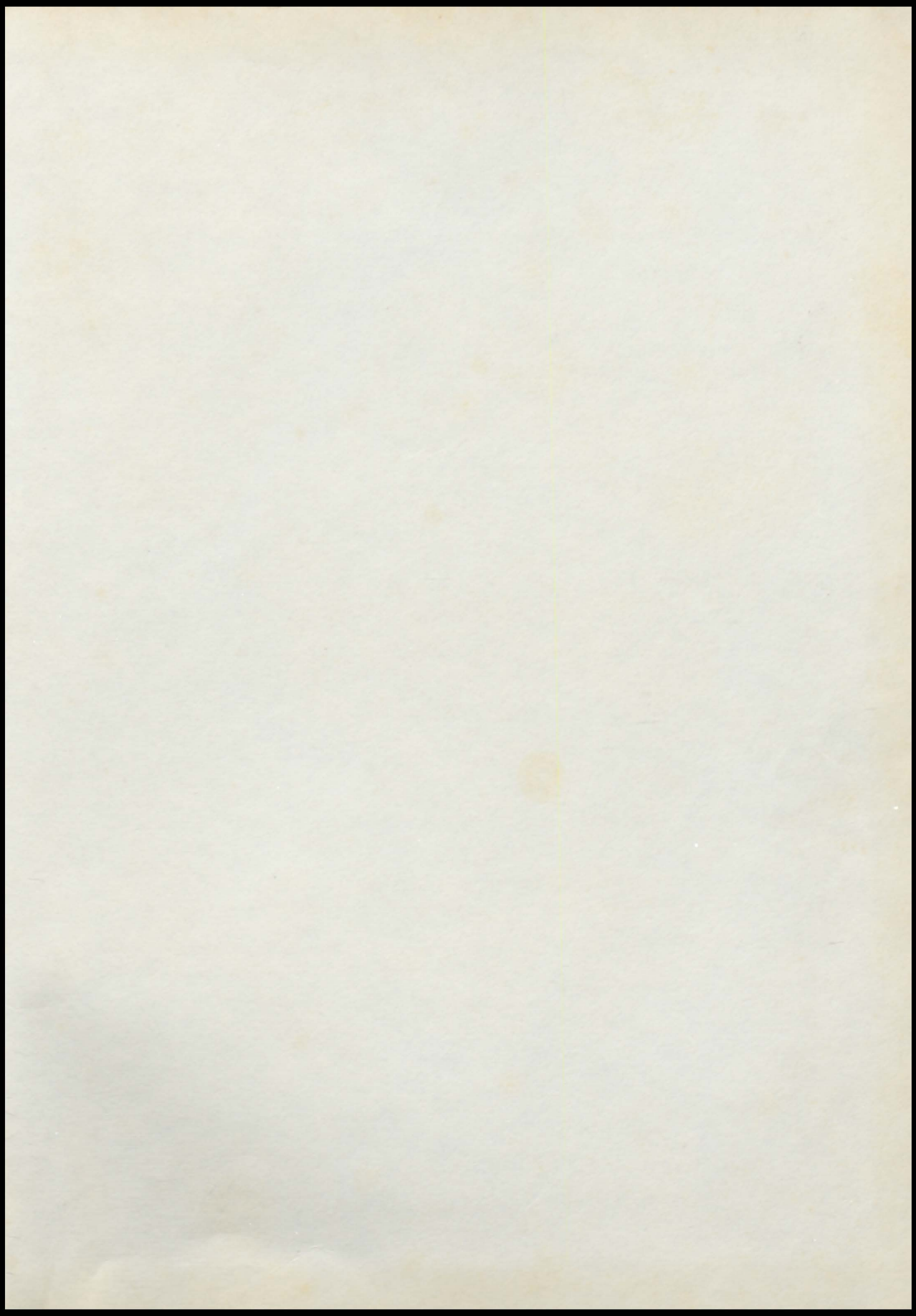
We started going to the Topic after games when Mrs. Dow said we'd have to pay to get into the Liner.

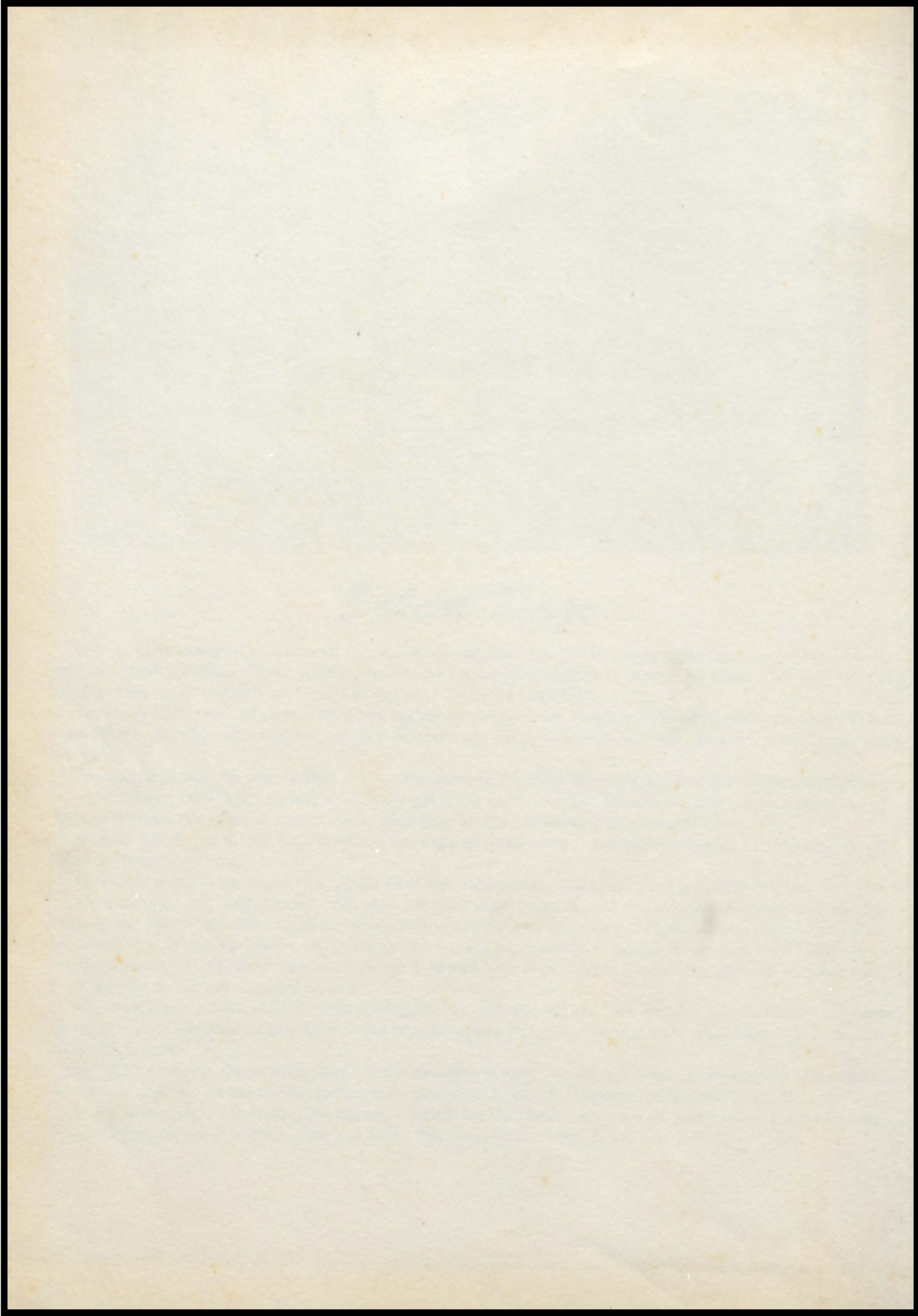

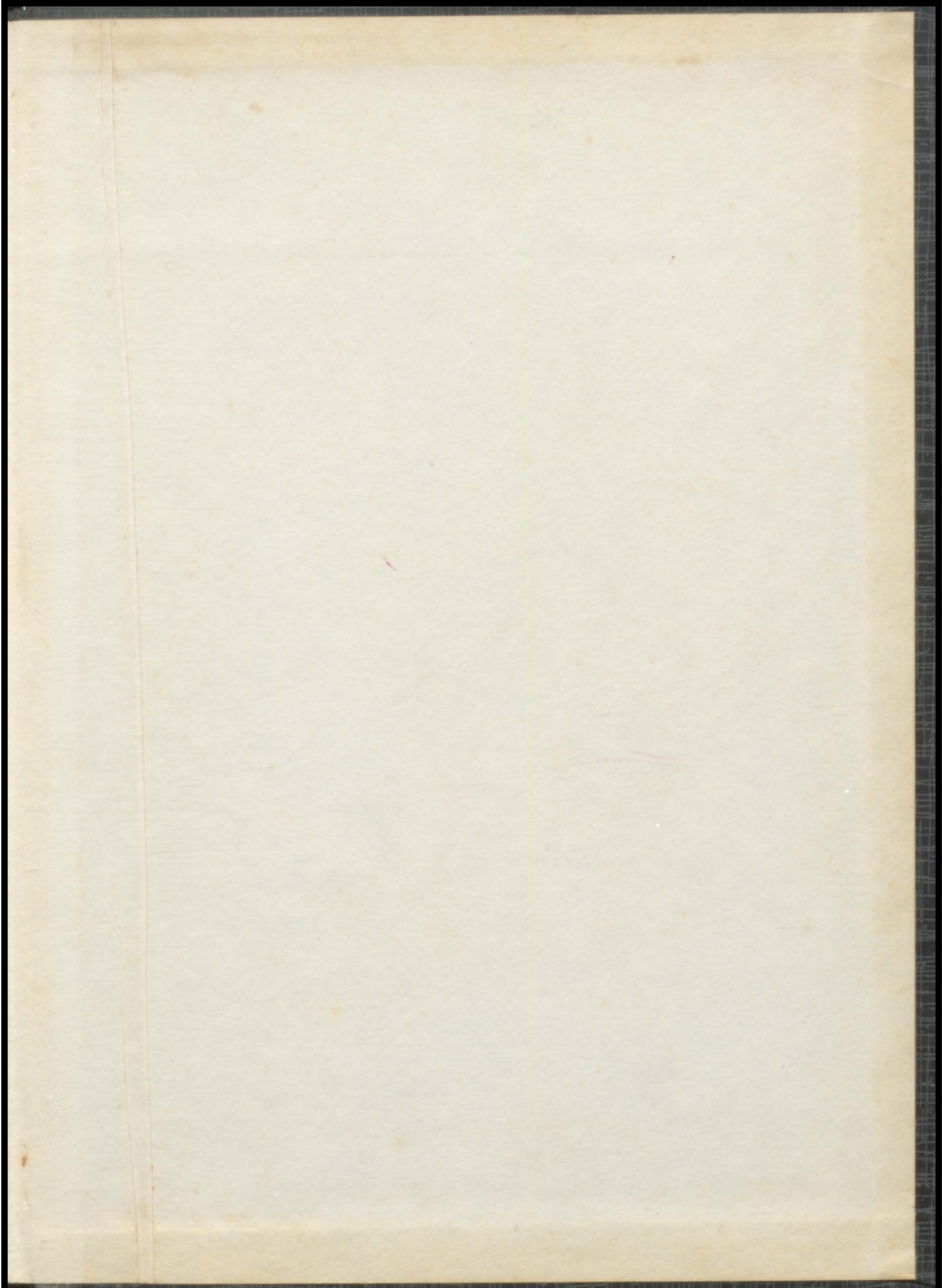
