Band

The band, under the direction of Mr. Halling had another eventful and exciting year. Its sixty pieces began the Fall season by going to the Minnesota-Washington football game and playing with about sixty other bands at half time. It was Minnesota's annual band day, and our second consecutive appearance at that event.

Later in the year it took part in the Homecoming Festivities, Christmas Concert, Spring Concert and then climaxed the school year with the Spring Festival. It is now looking forward to the summer appearances which consist of concerts, and out of town engagements in various parades held around the state. During one year the band averages from six to ten out of town appearances and about fifty appearances in town. It also plays at all basketball and football games during the school year.

The band practices five days a week during the school year. The concert band practices on Monday, Thursday and Friday. The second band, consisting of 40 pieces practices on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

The band is on a four-year program in order to assure and equal balance of instrumentation. A young bandsman may take part in a beginners band for about one year before becoming eligible for the second band. He then graduates to the concert band as soon as he is far enough advanced.

The band elects a group of officers which is responsible for taking care of the equipment and keeping the band running smoothly. This year's officers include Larry Brettingen, manager, Collette Ostrom, Beth Ann Roegge, librarians, Nancy Selleck, secretary, and Maurice Smith, Sandra Hanson, Carol Minar, uniforms.

The majorettes do an exceptionally fine job leading the band and playing in the concert band during the season. These majorettes include Collette Ostrom as head majorette, Darlene Grothe, Sharon Janssen, Judy Sommer, Gail Smith and Bonnie Ostrom.
