WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE Warrant No. 58913 for 120 acres, in favor of

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the south west quarter of section twenty nine and the south half of the south east quarter of section thirty in Township thirty north north of Range twenty one west in the District of lands formerly subject to sale at Stillwater now Cambridge Minnesota containing being one hundred and twenty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the SURVEYOR-GENERAL the said warrant having been assigned by the said John Boyle to one Amos Park in whose favor said tract has been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Amos Park as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: To HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Amos Park as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever.
