

Family tree on Wilcox side. Written up by Sally Wilcox from the records.  
John Wilcox - born in England in 1757 - came to New York while still a young man.  
Enlisted in Revolutionary war & served in the second company of the 2nd Regiment of  
the New York Line under Colonel Phillip Van Cortland & Captain Benjamin Peltz. John  
was a sergeant. Enlisted Feb. 14-1777 & served until June 1780. Reenlisted again  
in Aug 1780 & served until Jan 1782. Married Mary Crosby in New York City. They  
lived to Sardinia, Erie Co. New York in 1813 where he became a farmer. Had a  
family of 11 children, namely John, Charlotte, Henrietta, Jeremiah, Hiram, Samuel, Oliver,  
Mary, Roswell, Polly & Charles <sup>would be his great-grandfather</sup>.  
Now Charles married Barbara Wilkes in Erie Co. New York where he farmed un-  
til moving to Minn. in later years. They raised 7 children, namely Charles <sup>John D.</sup>,  
Merle, Edward, Francis, Myrtle & Nancy. Now Charles married Mary Fitch - farmed -  
had 5 children & is buried in Duriss, Minn. John <sup>John D. married</sup> Sara <sup>in 1800</sup> Lover - John D. born  
May 1829 - died Oct. 20-1912. He attended Griffith Academy & taught school in  
Springfield, Erie Co. In 1849 went to Cal. & worked for a mining company until  
1852. Returned to New York & in 1853 came to Minn., settling in Taylors Falls  
where he built a sawmill in that area. In 1862 joined the army & served  
thru 1864. He was in Company M, 1st. Mounted Rangers. He again taught school  
in Duriss until 1869 when he came to Brainerd & taught in the A-  
cademy there until 1872. Then he & his family moved to Pine City where he bought  
17 A. in village area & 160 A. in the country for general farming. He served his county  
as Superintendent of schools for 6 yrs. Judge of probate 4 yrs. County attorney 12 yrs. Regis-  
ter of Deeds 5 yrs. & County Surveyor for 10 yrs. (over)

1. Horace Wilcox - born 1841<sup>in Tommie</sup> never married - died? buried in Sunrise, Minn.  
~~1842 in Tommie~~ was a depot agent - died of a stroke.
  2. Florence born 1842 - was married to James Gray who was born in Vermont. He was a rural mail carrier. Lived in P.C. Children were Darwin C. Gray, Royal Gray, John Gray, Earl Gray & Lorenzo Gray - all deceased. Darwin, Royal, John & Florence were married - only Royal had 2 children. No idea where they are today if alive.
  3. Eugene Wilcox born 1865 in Sunrise but spent most of his life in P.C. area. He married Mary LaFever in 1902. Four children - Eugene died on the street in P.C. of a heart attack. Mary, his wife born in St. Paul & died of heart trouble in 1932.


Randall married Susan

Barney B. Clover was born in Montgomery Co. N.Y. in 1807. He married Abigail Reed of Massachusetts in 1829. He later moved to Cattaraugus Co. N.York. From there he moved by ox drawn carts to Senville, Minn. He was a mason & brick layer by trade in N.York but turned to farming in Minn. He was a Justice of the Peace for many yrs. He was a Presbyterian.

Ten children were born to them. Catherine M., Daniel, Mary L., Charlotte J., Morton P., Simon, Charles, John, Horace A., & Sarah A. He died in 1893 & at time of death lived with daughter Lizzie A. Wilson in Pine City. Buried in Senville, Minn. His wife preceded him in death & also 2 sons Simon & John.

John married Annette Lucas - 3 children - John, Barney & Nora.
