Aug 27 - 1936. Work Started on Dam - Federal government started work on construction of dam for Cross Lake & Pigeon Lake water project on Monday. The Dam will be located at the site of the original Chengwatawa Dam - about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west of the bridge. 14 men will start to work & the crew will increased to 50 men so the dam can be completed as soon as possible.

A. Max Munch, owner of Chengwatawa Dam & Mr Lang, the contractor who is putting in the same, spend Tuesday at the Dam looking over the work there. The Dam is about completed, but there is no bridge. Dam is completed and no prospects of one either unless the town of Chengwatawa comes to Mr Munch's term
