BOAT HARBOR, PICNIC AREA NOW UNDER CONSTRUCTION



Lions undertake river project

Work on a large scale boat harbor and picnic area project, being conducted by the Pine City Lions club, is now underway on the north side of the Snake river just west of the Highway 61 bridge in the village. The area, now useless because of its marshy condition, will be transformed by the Lions into an attractive new water recreation spot for Pine City. The plans call for a large horseshoe shaped canal which will sweep in behind and west of the VFW club. The 75 foot wide canal will surround a 100 by 175 foot island which will be planted in grass, shrubs and trees and will feature many picnic tables. A foot bridge will extend across the channel to the island. Construction is being done by the Paul Rydberg Construction company of Pine City.
